**INTRODUCTION**

Ghanzi District is undertaking another relocation of Ranyane residents to Bere and Chobokwane as from the 12 August 2013 to 20 August 2013. A total of 20 families have shown interest to be relocated, 11 households were assessed on 26/07/2013 - 28/07/2013 at Ranyane, 10 are already in Bere and have not been assessed among them is one Tsholetsa Mosetlana who has been disqualified from a list to be assisted as he is from Ncojane, two are Tshwaragano Gaorekwe and MC Donald Asosual Kereng who originate from Mokhomba in Ngwaketse west and lived in Ranyane for the past three years to work. 7 others are to be assessed. (refer to table 1 for the assessed people).

**RECOMMENDATIONS**

This move will help to remove Non RADS who were relocated from the council borehole in the long run.
2. Request for names of Ranyane residents making the 182 population of Ranyane in the 2011 census report such that only Ranyane residents are relocated.
3. Court case applicants who will be relocated should sign avadavat to ascertain that they have truly communicated with their lawyers about relocation.
