Their land, our future conservation principles

for a new conservation respecting tribal peoples' rights for all of humanity

- 1 Tribal peoples are generally the best conservationists; they have managed their lands sustainably for many generations.
- 2 Forcibly removing tribal peoples usually results in environmental damage.
- 3 Such removals are a violation of human rights and should be opposed by conservationists.
- 4 The cheapest and quickest way to conserve areas of high biodiversity is to respect tribal peoples' rights.
- 5 The world can no longer afford a conservation model which destroys tribal peoples: it damages human diversity as well as the environment.
