Golden Bonds are guaranteed running places that Survival purchases from the marathon organisers. Due to this, Survival's Golden Bond runners are asked to pledge at least £1,700 in sponsorship. We ask our runners to pay a £300 refundable deposit as a guarantee that they will raise or exceed the amount that they pledge.

2022 TCS London Marathon Terms and Conditions

With one of our Golden Bond places you are guaranteed entry into the 2022 London Marathon. You can apply for a Golden Bond place even if you have entered the London Marathon's general ballot. If you are lucky enough to get a ballot place, you can still run for Survival and your Golden Bond place will be awarded to another applicant.

Please read the following Terms & Conditions carefully.

Minimum fundraising commitment

1. Survival has a limited number of Golden Bond places. You can apply if you pledge to compete in the 2022 TCS London Marathon for Survival, and pay in a declared sponsorship equal to or greater than £1,700 to Survival by 1st January 2023. Your application will be subject to a selection process, to ensure that Golden Bond places are used to the best possible effect (as determined by Survival).

*Matched funding does not count towards your minimum sponsorship.

£300 Deposit

2. You agree to pay a £300 deposit to Survival, as a guarantee that you will raise, or exceed, the amount that you pledge in your application form. Survival will refund your deposit no later than 28 days after you have paid in your pledged amount of sponsorship money. Survival reserves the right to keep all (or part of) your £300 deposit if you pay in less than your pledged amount on the 1st January 2023.

3. If your application is successful, Survival will contact you to explain how to make payment of your deposit. You must pay the deposit within 10 days of notification; otherwise you may risk losing your guaranteed place to another applicant.

4. If your application for a Golden Bond place is not immediately successful, Survival will notify you if you have been placed on Survival's reserve list for Golden Bond places.

Paying your sponsorship funds to Survival

5. Any existing regular donations that you make to Survival do not form part of the total raised through sponsorship.

6. Monies reclaimed by Survival under the HMRC Gift Aid scheme do not count towards the total value of your sponsorship.

7. Survival will advise you on the recommended way(s) to pay in your sponsorship. This is to ensure that Survival can easily trace funds that you pay in. Survival cannot be liable for cheques lost in the post,

or monies paid to Survival in any way other than those specified by Survival.

The amount, which Survival deems to have been raised by you, will be the amount that Survival has recognized as having been paid into its bank account by you.

8. Payment deadline for sponsorship is the 1st January 2023. If you need more time to collect sponsorship, please let Survival know in writing in advance of this date. Survival will refund your £300 deposit within 28 days of receiving sponsorship payments that equal or exceed the value of the amount that you pledge.

Cancelling a Golden Bond place

9. If you cancel your Golden Bond place because you have gained your own place in the 2022 TCS London Marathon's general ballot, and you are still running to raise funds for Survival, you must notify Survival by the 1st March 2022. Survival will refund your £300 deposit and re-allocate your place to a runner on its reserve list. If you do not contact Survival by this date, you risk forfeiting part or all of your £300 deposit.

10. If you decide not to run the 2022 TCS London Marathon – or decide to run for another charity – you must inform Survival before the 1st March 2022. Survival will take a £50 administration fee from your £300 deposit, and refund the remainder within 28 days. If you do not inform Survival before this date you will forfeit all of your £300 deposit.

Deferring your place because of injury

11. If you sustain a training injury after the 1st March 2022, please inform Survival in writing before race day. Please include a letter from your physician verifying your training injury. It is important that you do not take part in the 2022 TCS London Marathon unless you are completely fit to do so. Survival will defer your place and your £300 deposit to the following year. However, you must agree to the Terms and Conditions that Survival publishes for the 2023 London Marathon. This includes any increase in the amount of sponsorship money you pledge to raise.
