Last year, the Bushmen of Botswana won an historic victory.

Expelled from their ancient homeland, the Bushmen took the government to court – and won.

Botswana's High Court ruled that the Bushmen have the right to return to their land, and to hunt and gather there. That's all they've ever wanted.

But since then, the government has:

**ARRESTED** MORE THAN 50 BUSHMEN FOR HUNTING TO FEED THEIR FAMILIES.

**BANNED** THE BUSHMEN FROM USING THEIR WATER BOREHOLE DURING ONE OF THE FIERCEST DROUGHTS IN YEARS.

**BACKED** PLANS FOR A MASSIVE DIAMOND MINE WORTH \$2.2 BILLION ON THE BUSHMEN'S LAND.

Meanwhile, hundreds still languish in resettlement camps, unable or too scared to return home.
